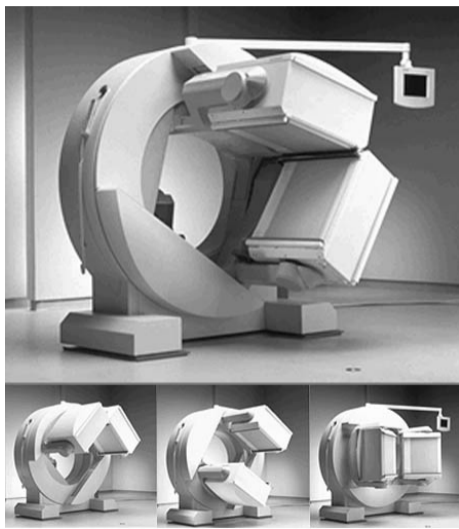

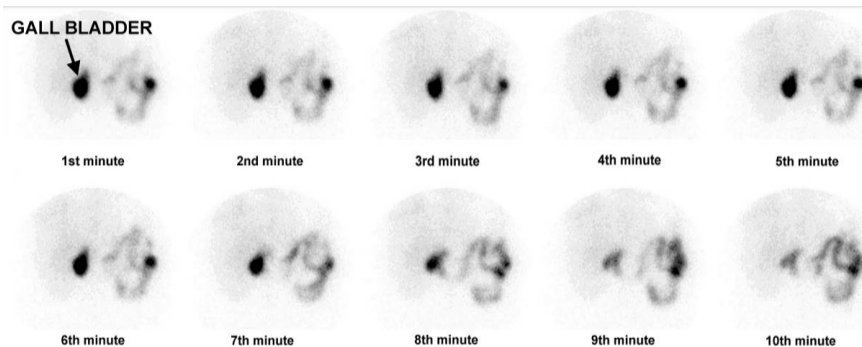

Gamma cameras



Dynamic imaging study



- ^{99m}Tc -HIDA
- At $t = 7$ mins, cholecystkinin was administered to simulate emptying of the gallbladder
- Rate of emptying can be measured from the sequence
